- HSB & OES will again ring bells for the Salvation Army from 8:00am to 8pm on Saturday December 12, 2020 at Econo-Foods.

STEAMBOAT DINNER----Saturday March 13, 2021.

- The **Dining Room** will **not** be open to the public.
- The **Drive-Thru** will be **open**
- We will, as in the past, make needed **Deliveries** of donated dinners.
- The 501c3 entities that distribute our Donated Tickets indicate there is a **greater need this year** primarily due to COVID-19.
- We have increased our Goal from 725 to 850 with a **Challenge Goal of 900**. Last year 863 Donated Tickets were purchased exceeding even our Challenge Goal of 775.
- We have been contacting businesses who last year purchased Donated Tickets and the response has been very good. Lodge member response has also been strong. OES again contributed \$800.
- As of 11/26/20 we have received \$6,515 from 36 donors for 407 Donated Tickets. We also have commitments for 46 more tickets for a total of 453. This represents 53% of our Goal and 50% of our Challenge Goal!
