The Grand Lodge has made it easy to pay the assessment via PayPal on the Grand Lodge website. Lodge secretaries were also sent letters to compile a list of all members they


remit dues for and given the ability to send in payments for those Brothers.







ANCIENT ACCEPTED SCOTTISH RITE OF FREEMASONRY VALLEY OF GREEN BAY
