HOW TO PAY THE MASONIC CENTER \$10 ASSESSMENT

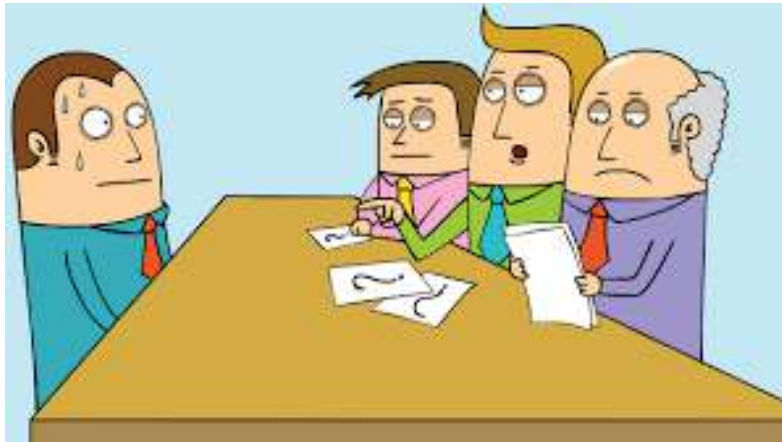
