Did any of you know that Jimmy the Ground Hog in Sun Prairie was a Mason? Well, as the story goes, he was. Back in 1965, a couple in Sun Prairie who were taking over the responsibility for the Sun Prairie celebration for the 4H needed an idea for a ground hog. A gentleman in town named Jim Weigen helped them acquire the first Jimmy. Thus, was born Jimmy the Ground Hog. Jim Weigen was a member of both the Sun Prairie lodge as well as my lodge, Doric. Jim was blind but had memorized all the masonic work. I had the privilege of learning much of my work from him. He also would put on dinners to help the Jobies in Sun Prairie raise money for their robes and chapter. I know this as my mother was the Bethel Guardian at the time. So, in all, Jimmy the Ground Hog (9th generation) of Sun Prairie was and is a Mason.
