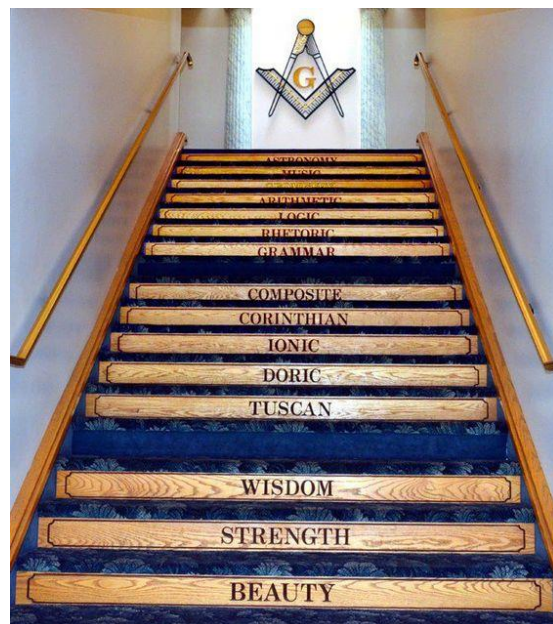
STEAMBOAT DINNER---All is on schedule

As we go into the coming months, we may well have a number of degree's being conferred. The candidates would love to see you on the side lines.

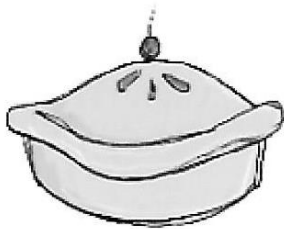
