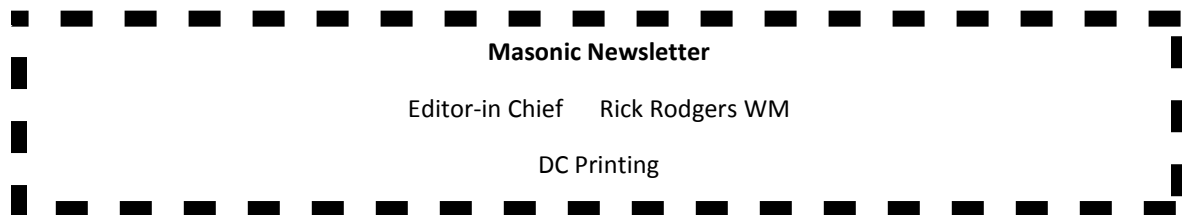
Calendar worthy events!!
