Thankfully, formatting problems delayed the publication of the newsletter until today, and now there is important new information to share. Here is the latest information from our Worthy Grand Matron:

Dear Sisters and Brothers

Discussions were held with the WGM, WGP, AGM, AGP, Grand Trustees, Chairmen of the Jurisprudence and Finance Committees concerning rescheduling the 2020 Grand Chapter Session. It was decided that trying to reschedule this summer was not possible due to the current uncertainty of group meetings. It was therefore decided to delay Grand Chapter to May of 2021. Article VIII Paragraph 9 Section 1(b) The WGM, should an emergency arise will select a date and place with the approval of the Grand Trustees.

- Grand Chapter Officers and Committees will remain in their positions until May 2021. Please let WGM Laramie or WGP Ian know if you are unable to remain.
- Subordinate Chapter Officers will remain in their positions with new elections in April 2021. If there are undue hardship reasons i.e. medical, I will consider requests on a case by case basis. Permission is **required** from the WGM to hold elections at a time other than April 2021.
- Resolutions and Business will carry over to 2021.
- Official Visits will not be held until 2021-2022. A Grand Officer will schedule a time to inspect the books and records of each chapter in order to compile the reports needed for Grand Chapter in 2021. A schedule will be sent this summer. This may or may not be at a chapter meeting.
- 2020-2021 Dues cards are being sent to Chapter Secretaries and Annual Reports and Per Capita are due August 1, 2020.
- Sister Terri and Brother Leonard have appointed Grand Representatives in anticipation of their Installation this May. They will be delivering these personally. WGP Ian and I will be keeping any dates scheduled with Sister Terri and Brother Leonard.
- All checks for Grand Chapter 2020 will be returned if requested. None will be deposited. Please allow time for this to happen.

This has been a difficult time for all of us. Please keep yourselves safe. You, the members, are the most important part of Eastern Star. We will meet again.

The Wisconsin Eastern Star Foundation is the charitable part of the Grand Chapter, Order of Eastern Star of Wisconsin. Through the work of the Foundation, we are able to provide assistance to our Sisters and Brothers during a time of need: whether it is due to illness, unanticipated home or auto repairs, loss of employment or accident.

The funds come from the income of our investment accounts. They are awarded to members based on completion and review of an application. Applications are available from your chapter secretary, on the Grand Chapter website under forms or from the Foundation secretary. Assistance is granted upon review of applications from members. Members are encouraged to apply. All assistance must meet IRS rules for non-profit foundations. The OES Foundation board meets four times during the year to review applications. The current Worthy Grand Patron is President. The Worthy Grand Matron and line officers are members as well as five members appointed by the Worthy Grand Matron. The secretary and treasurer positions are elected annually from the appointed members.
