Brother Elmer John Janka, PGP

Once again, our Golden chain has been broken with the passing of Past Grand Patron Brother Elmer John Janka, age 93, of Wautoma. Elmer died on Saturday April 13, 2019; he was born in Cudahy on Aug. 29, 1925 to Joseph and Louise (Miller) Janka.

After high school, Elmer joined the U.S. Army and served in the European Theatre during WWII with the 1st Infantry Division with the Signal Corp. On July 5, 1947 he married Sylvia A. Lyss in Milwaukee. Elmer worked with the Milwaukee Police Department and retired in 1979, then moved to the Wautoma Area. He also enjoyed hunting and fishing.

Elmer was initiated into Wautoma Chapter #198 on July 16, 1984. He petitioned for dual membership in Waupaca Chapter #197 on July 12, 1999 and elected to dual membership on October 13, 1999. He served as Worthy Patron in Wautoma for many years. Past Grand Matron Sister Joanne Wettereau and Past Grand Patron Brother Don Haas appointed Elmer as Grand Sentinel; he was elected to serve the state of Wiconsin as Worthy Grand Patron along with Past Grand Matron Carla Badgley. Their theme was "Circle of Love' and how approriate Elmer's Bible verse was from John 3:18 "Our love should not be just words and talk; it must be true love, which shows itself in action". The aim: In all we do let us do it in love. When his Worthy Grand Matron was unable to attend their session due to an accident, Elmer worked nicely with Past Grand Matron, Sister Theda Andres, who being a true friend, followed all the work and plans Carla put into preparing for their session and doing so very graciously. That is true friendship and love fully coming to fruition as they had hoped for as they laid out their plans. Elmer always had a smile on his face and made everyone feel they were special. He was always happy when he could enjoy fellowship with the membership, especially if they served Lemon Bars. Elmer was also a member of Shriners and the Masons. The Marguardt Hospice group arranged for a WWII pinning ceremony for Elmer. It was very special for him. He will be sadly missed by his family and friends.

Elmer is survived by his children: Dennis Janka, Cindy (Phil Albo) Janka; grandson: Shane Nigbor and family; special grandson Sam; niece and nephew: Pam and Ken Rehbein who help Elmer over the years with different projects and odds and ends around the house; other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents; wife Sylvia Janka; two infant children; daughterin-law Glenda Nigbor; and granddaughter Jennifer Albo. Private services will be held at a later date.

The family wishes to thank the staff of Marquardt Hospice for the care and compassion shown to Elmer.

In tribute to our beloved Brother, we ask every subordinate chapter to drape their charter for a period of thirty (30) days in loving memory of our departed Brother.

So, What's Going to Happen With the Monthly Newsletter?

As you will recall, last year at Grand Chapter, the membership overwhelmingly voted to start the monthly newsletter and to provide it to each member for a trial period of one year. While this was not the original intent of the proposal (providing it by email was), it seems the project has been very successful, but VERY costly.

We have analyzed the costs and determined that it costs just under \$15 <u>per person</u> per year to produce and send paper copies of the newsletter. In addition, postage costs will again be increasing in June 2019. Sending the newsletter via email does not have any inherent costs.


The Grand Chapter Trustees, the Grand Treasurer and Secretary, the Grand Line Officers, and the Finance, Ways, and Means Committee have discussed some of the options available: 1) Discontinue the newsletter and go back to producing the "monthly mailing" as has been done in the past, which are sent only to select members and those who pay for it, and are read at each Chapter meeting;

2) Continue to send the newsletter to every member according to their preference and consider an increase in per capita to cover the cost of paper copies; or

3) Provide email copies for no cost to the membership and charge those who receive paper copy the cost of producing the communication in such a format.

Members will have the opportunity to discuss these options at Grand Chapter during the discussion of the proposed budget. The budget, as proposed by the Finance Committee, includes provisions for charging for the receipt of paper copy, as well as charging for the inclusion of "ads" for Chapter events, etc. in the newsletter. Finance Committee is proposing a \$10 fee for quarter page ad; \$20 for half page; and \$30 for a full page ad. This is what the Finance Committee is proposing; the membership may vote for a different solution. If you have an opinion about what should happen with the newsletter, come to Grand Chapter and participate in the discussion and vote regarding the budget.

Regardless of the outcome of the vote on the budget, the last issue of this year's newsletter will be the June issue. In anticipation of the possibility of charging for paper copy of the newsletter, the subscription form on the back page is provided with the intent of helping plan for changes.

I am honored to have been asked by our Most Worthy Grand Matron to serve on the Membership Committee for General Grand Chapter for this Triennial. The theme is: "Circle of Friendship & Service Around the World" for Sister Marianne Shenefelt, Most Worthy Grand Matron and Brother Henry S. Martin, Most Worthy Grand Patron. Sister Marianne and Brother Henry have designated "membership" as one of their "focus" projects for this Triennial.

The Goal for this Triennium: To provide the wherewithal through magazines, newspapers, brochures and any other publications, making people cognizant of the Order of the Eastern Star, thus increasing membership in all Grand Jurisdictions and Subordinate Chapters under the General Grand Chapter. It is also desired to achieve higher retention of our new members and reward our existing members for their dedicated work.

Sister Marianne is offering several new programs for the Triennial, as well as supporting some existing ones. The following is a list of the programs and a brief description.

1. Rob Morris Jewel and Bars for members signing Petitions for the Degrees and Reinstatement Petitions. This has been an on-going project for many years. You can see many members proudly wearing their Rob Morris Jewel and Bars. Guidelines and forms are on the General Grand Chapter website.

2. "Mother Hen" project, which is a <u>mentoring program</u> to help improve the retention of these new and/or returning members by reinstatement. This is an initiative project of rewarding the mentor (big sister/brother) upon report of satisfactory mentor assistance to these new members, such as continued support following initiation or return by reinstatement. Simple guidelines have been developed to determine if satisfactory assistance has been accomplished. A "Mother Hen" pin is available to your jurisdiction to successful mentors who have successfully utilized the program.

3. "Awesome Twosome" ribbon award. These 5 ribbons in the Star Point Colors are available:

Blue Ribbon: Yellow Ribbon: White Ribbon: Green Ribbon: Red Ribbon: Awesome Twosome Terrific Threesome Fantastic Foursome Fabulous Five Remarkable Six

This program is to reward and recognize new members initiated or reinstated in a group and to encourage members to initiate or reinstate 2 or more people together. The ribbon is worn by the new members. For example: a husband and wife initiated together would receive the "Awesome Twosome" ribbon. Three initiated together would receive the "Terrific Threesome" ribbon, and so on. The purpose is to encourage several to join or come back together.

4. Publicity of our Order. Possibly members in your jurisdiction are doing benevolent projects already that are worthy of publication. Getting the word out about our Order is a priority in membership awareness. One of Sister Marianne's projects is the Service Dog Program. This would be an excellent source for us to contact non-members and show off our Order.

Many jurisdictions have committees for membership and to assist General Grand Chapter with the different projects for the Triennium. If you have a committee in place, please advise me of the names and contact information of the contact person/persons. If you choose to participate in any of these programs, this chairperson could be my contact for information and distribution of materials. I would also like to connect all the membership committees in my jurisdictions together so that they may share programs and information with one another.

I may be sending you information on additional programs as the Triennium progresses.

As the General Grand Chapter Membership Committee Chairman, I will attempt to visit as many Grand Chapter Sessions as possible during this Triennium. If you have any questions about the Rob Morris Jewel and Bars for members signing petitions, the newly added "Mother Hen" and "Awesome Twosome" projects, and sharing information about our Order while attracting new members please let me know.

Please let me know if you have any questions. One of the members of this committee will be contacting you and/or one of your Worthy Grand Matrons for this triennial with a suggested date to attend one of your sessions.

My hope for this triennial is to see our membership grow. I believe working with all the Grand Jurisdictions is the key. We all have good ideas to share to make us stronger. I look forward to working with you.

ROB MORRIS MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM 2018-2021

"CIRCLE OF FRIENDSHIP & SERVICE AROUND THE WORLD"

Sister Marianne Shenefelt, MWGM and Brother Henry S. Martin, MWGP will continue the Rob Morris Award Program for sisters and brothers who sign petitions.

A Rob Morris Membership Jewel is awarded by General Grand Chapter to members who sign petitions as follows:

- 100 points Top line signer of a Petition for the Degrees.
- 50 points Second line signer of a Petition for the Degrees.
- 50 points Reinstatement by Affiliation (Top line or second line signer).

For 300 points, a member qualifies for a Rob Morris Membership Jewel. Then, a member may earn a triennium date bar for an additional 300 points to attach to the jewel (see picture of Jewel and bar above).

NOTE:

- Points may be carried over from the previous triennium (2015-2018).
- Points cannot be shared.
- Members need to sign the petitions and earn the points on their own.
- Points earned since November 2015 can be added to points earned this triennium.
- We do have some 2015-2018 bars left. Please make sure to specify if you want one of the previous bars.

Requests for jewels and bars should be submitted on the proper form (sent to subordinate Chapter Secretaries) with the <u>Seal of the</u> <u>Chapter</u>. Our policy is to send all of the awards to the Chapter Secretary. If the award is needed for a special awards ceremony, send an email to me at the address below and I will make sure you have it by the date needed (if notified timely).
