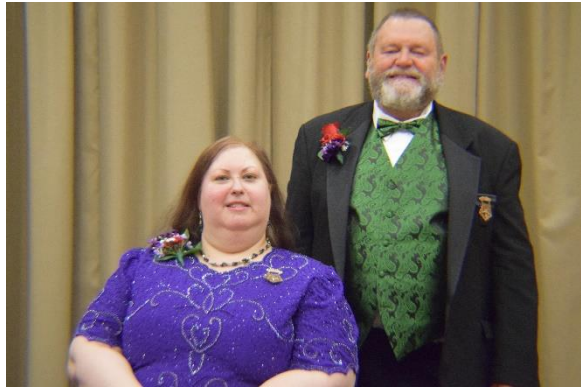

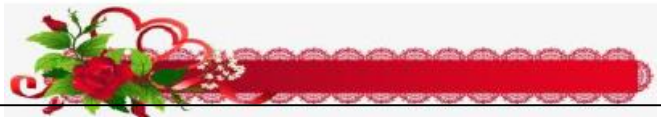

## *Message from our WGM: Wisconsin Chapters Are Reopening*

Sisters and Brothers,

I know you were excited when I announced the reopening of Chapters in June during my acceptance speech at Grand Chapter. After the excitement came the questions as to how this will happen. **Chapters will reopen as of June 1, 2021.**

I would like to encourage all chapters to have a social gathering for their members to provide our Sisters and Brothers the chance to get reacquainted in a relaxed environment. This may be held before or after your first meeting if you meet in the first week of the month. Some chapters have not been together in over a year and a half. It may be held at the lodge or in a park. **If a meal or snacks are provided, only commercially prepared food may be served. Individuals may bring their own food and drink as long as there is no sharing.** Bottled water should be provided.

You may hold any and all fundraisers, as long as they are done safely. **If the fundraiser involves making and cooking food items** masks and gloves are to be worn at all times.

I will be issuing a blanket dispensation covering elections and installations. Per code, we are to have elections in April and installations in June. Chapters are being allowed to have these completed by the end of October. Please do not hold both elections and installation at the same meeting. As long as you inform your members before your 1st meeting, you may hold elections that night. If your chapter is normally closed during the summer months, you can hold your installation during those months or wait until September or October. Please inform the Grand Secretary and I of when you will be holding your installations so we may let other chapters know and to hopefully let visitors know as we help you celebrate the start of a new term. Chapter Secretaries, please print out the dispensations (in this newsletter and attach them to your meetings that you have your elections and installations.

We hope that you will be able to have a quorum of 7 members at your meetings. If your members are comfortable coming to meetings, gladly welcome them back! If your members are not yet comfortable coming to meetings, let them know we will gladly welcome them back when they are! Please do not make members feel bad if they are not yet comfortable. Keep all members up to date on meetings. With this, if you are not able to have a quorum, please still hold your meeting. I will not punish a chapter as we are slowly opening. This will change later in the year as more members get their vaccinations and feel safer coming out to meetings.

As of June 1, 2021 zoom chapter meetings will stop. Only membership and social zooms will be continuing. Zoom chapter meetings were only allowed during the closure. If we have to close the chapters again, the zoom meetings can start up at that time.

Certain things we can and can't do during a meeting:

- Masks must be worn by all members, even if fully vaccinated. This will change later in the year but to begin with, we will all be masked. When speaking, you may lower or take off your mask and then replace it when done speaking.
- Flag must still be presented and retired, but by the Associate Patron or the Flag Bearer only. No Conductresses as a guard of honor.
- NO SINGING. This may also change later in the year but to begin with, no singing.
- We may have initiations, ask the candidate how comfortable they are with groups. The Conductresses may ask the candidate to follow instead of offering their arm and stand a bit farther back from the star points when they give their lecture.
- Everyone present must check in with the Chapter Secretary so they may keep a very accurate attendance in case anything happens.
- Have hand sanitizers at the entrance to the chapter room and on the Secretary desk and please use these often.
- During introductions, if you are to be introduced, you have the option of either being presented or introduced from your place. If presented, you are to only follow the Conductresses.
- There may be refreshments following the meeting, but serving only store bought items, no homemade items at this time. This will change later in the year. Please have bottled water, soda, milk, juice available.

The Grand Master of Masons in Wisconsin has rescinded all of his COVID restrictions and has put the Worshipful Masters in charge of their lodge COVID safety. All federal, state and local counties may still have some health orders concerning groups. These are to be followed to the strictest letter. Please make sure that areas and items we use are sanitized after the meeting, including Conductress staffs, Marshal baton, star point emblems if they are used, chair handles, organ, podiums and Secretary desk.

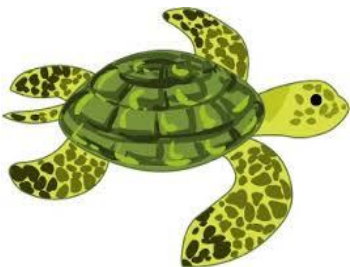
