We are approaching the anniversary of the Covid19 pandemic. On March 13 we stopped in person meetings. We have learned how to "zoom" and wear masks and social distance. Will our lives ever be able to go back to the way it was before?

After much thought and coordinating it was decided to hold a 2-day Grand Chapter session May 18-19 for WI members only. It will be business only session. There will not be ceremonies or services. We will open Tuesday afternoon at 1 pm. Installation will be Wednesday afternoon. The Grand Officers will maintain social distancing. WGP Ian and I will open each session. The Grand Chapter floor will be smaller and there will be more space on the sidelines. Chairs will be grouped 2 together with space between groups. Masks are REQUIRED. #### JUNE BJORKLUND

Once again, the golden chain in Wisconsin Grand Chapter is broken with the passing of Past Grand Matron Sister June Bjorklund on Friday, January 29, 2021 at the Masonic Health Care Center in Dousman at the age of 97. She was born on June 9, 1923, in Milwaukee, WI, the daughter of Herbert and Lillian (nee Buntrock) Poetzl. On November 26, 1949 she married Albin Bjorklund. Initiated into the Order of the Eastern Star in Chapter 55, she later served as Worthy Matron. Sister June also represented the District of Columbia in Wisconsin in 2004-2006.

Sister June proudly served her country in the U.S. Navy in The WAVES during World War II, so therefore it was no surprise that she carried out this theme during the special time of her life when she served as Worthy Grand Matron of Wisconsin in 1994-1995. "God Bless America" was the title of her session with PGP Brother Howard Trescher. She would more than likely be patriotically dressed in red, white and blue attire, which she carried out nicely during her term in the Grand East. One can remember Sister June, Brother Howard and Sister Marion being so jovial and enjoying each other's company as they traveled the state spreading their Fraternal Love to their Sisters and Brothers. Yes, she truly maintained her love of her country, her flag and her sisters and brothers of the Order of the Eastern Star throughout her term and beyond.

PGP Brother Ron Pete wrote their march in which he incorporated "Anchors Away" which was very special to Sister June. As Brother Ron stated it was known June did not like to cook, so he would tease her about using her oven as a place to store her undergarments. I can just picture June laughing and slapping her hip as she so often did when expressing her humor. June was a very vivacious, independent person with a great sense of humor, a very infectious laugh, and a great conversationalist.

One of her more notable accomplishments was writing the script and portraying many different Women of the Bible in dramatic programs throughout the state. If you were ever fortunate to hear one her portrayals, of which she did many, you would feel transported to Biblical times, as she was an awesome storyteller.

She was a cracker jack stenographer/secretary, one of the very few who could still take dictation in shorthand. She was very proficient in all her endeavors and especially adamant that a boat is NOT a ship. If someone would mention anything about being on boat-she would say it is a ship not a boat as "You can't put a ship on a boat, but you can put a boat on a ship". We have many great memories of Past Grand Matron Sister June, and we will treasure each one.

She will also be sadly missed by her daughter Susan (Scott) Wilson of Colgate along with her grandchildren Carrie (Jason) Stobba and Dan (Julie) Wilson and great-grandson Ben Wilson. She was preceded in death by her husband Albin in 1976 and her sisters Mardell (Kenneth) Williams and Marilyn (Oliver) Williams. Services will be held in late summer or early fall 2021. Memorials in June's name are appreciated to First Congregational United Church of Christ, 100 E. Broadway, Waukesha, WI 53186 or the charity of donor's choice.

We are thankful for the years Sister June gave of herself to the Order of the Eastern Star. Blessed be her memory. We request that this Memorial be read at the first Stated Meeting and the Charter be draped for a period of thirty days in memory of our departed Sister.
