**QUALIFICATIONS AND DUTIES
FOR GRAND SECRETARY**

OF THE GRAND CHAPTER, ORDER OF THE EASTERN STAR OF WISCONSIN

QUALIFICATIONS

Any member who meets the eligibility requirements of Article IV, Section 1 of the Code of Laws of the Grand Chapter of Wisconsin, and who aspires to the Office of Grand Secretary should have leadership ability and be self-motivated; have a good working knowledge of office procedure; superior communication skills, both written and verbal; the ability to maintain the ledgers and accounts of the Order; advanced computer skills and the ability to assist in keeping the organization's website up to date; and to properly serve as a Grand Chapter Officer at all Grand Chapter functions at the discretion of the Worthy Grand Matron.

SALARY determined annually by the Grand Chapter budget as approved at the Grand Session.

HOURS 18 hours per week. Schedule to be determined by the Worthy Grand Matron. **Vacation:** two weeks after serving as Grand Secretary for one year.

DUTIES

The Grand Secretary shall perform all the duties as a Grand Chapter Officer and as outlined in the Code of Laws, Article VI, Paragraph 7, Section 5 and as the functioning secretary of the Grand Chapter, in an appropriate and business-like manner and as directed by the Worthy Grand Matron.

These duties shall include, but are not limited to:

- Receive all correspondence addressed to the Grand Chapter.
- Record, complete and invoice all requests from subordinate Chapters and members for supplies.
- Prepare the Monthly Newsletter with information from the Worthy Grand Matron and Chapters.
- Determine eligibility for Life Membership (50 years of membership) and notify Chapter Secretaries.
- Receive and record all monies due to the Grand Chapter forward the monies to the Grand Treasurer for deposit, receive his/her receipt for the monies turned over.
- Maintain the Membership Database.
- Receive and record all statements for material and/or services, including payroll, and issue warrants to be paid by the Grand Treasurer.
- Serve as an ex-officio member of the Finance, Ways and Means Committee and shall act, at the direction of the Chairman of the Committee, as the Committee Secretary.
- Execute all orders issued by the Worthy Grand Matron and deliver all books, papers and other property belonging to the Grand Chapter in her/his possession to her/his successor in office.
- Process Grand Representative Appointments of other Grand Jurisdictions in WI and of WI in other Grand Jurisdictions.
- Prepare Material for the Proceedings.
- Prepare and send the replacement pages for the Code and Red Book changes enacted at the Grand Chapter Session.
- Receive Annual Reports and enter in computer.
- Prepare materials for Exemplifications, Sign-up Sheets, etc.
- Complete and submit Grand Chapter Annual Report to General Grand Chapter.
- Order the Dues Receipts for the Chapters from General Grand Chapter.
- Send Resolutions received to the Chairman of the Constitutional Amendments Committee.
- Prepare Tentative Grand Session Program with WGM and send appropriate invitations.
- Work with Associate Grand Matron to prepare Secretary and Worthy Matron packets for Grand Chapter.
- Pack Grand Secretary supplies, copies of the Resolutions, and copies of the Budget for all voting members for Grand Chapter.

TO BE SHARED WITH OES MEMBERSHIP

April 22, 2021

Sisters and Brothers,

Over the last months, there has been increased diversity of Covid restrictions throughout each State, Province, Country and local areas. For this reason, I hereby rescind my temporary guidelines and directives that modified the ritualistic work of our Ritual due to Covid, but only if returning to performing the ritualistic ceremonies as directed in the Ritual does not violate your locale's Covid restrictions. Eastern Star does not need to be in the newspapers or on the news as an organization that does not follow required Covid restrictions. This is not the kind of publicity we need!

Please note: If the decision is made by leadership to return to doing regular ritualistic work, please do not do part of the work as directed in the Ritual and part of the work using the temporary modifications.

The Covid-19 virus has not been totally contained or eradicated. I urge continued caution when deciding what is safe for our members when resuming in-person OES meetings, activities and functions and returning to doing the ritualistic work without modifications. Members are not to be pressured to participate if they feel unsafe or are concerned about their health. If your area continues to have strict Covid restrictions, continued use of my temporary guidelines and directives for Covid are acceptable, and using Zoom or other video conferencing methods to conduct a Chapter's necessary business is acceptable.

With regard to the end of my guidelines and directives due to Covid, please let it be understood that the decision to cancel the GGC 50th Triennial Assembly in Salt Lake City, Utah, has not changed. The Assembly has been canceled and will remain canceled.

I am grateful for each one of you, and for your dedication and willingness to work together to move our Order safely forward into the future where better times most surely await us! Thank you, my Sisters and Brothers.
