RED BOOK TIPS

Star Points handling of ribbons and emblems during Initiation (see pages 154 -157 for detailed instructions)

RIBBONS:

- To pick up ribbon, step to back edge of chair, square behind the pedestal and face East, pick up ribbon with right hand, then square back to the side of the chair.
- Begin the ribbon portion of the lecture. When saying, "The color appropriate to this degree is blue, yellow, white, green or red", step forward and give the ribbon to the new member closest to the Altar, then to the rest of the new members. Another way to remember which new member receives the ribbon first is the new member closest to the Star Point pedestal.
- Do not speak while handing out the ribbons. When giving the ribbon to the last new member, finish the lecture on the ribbon. After finished speaking, step back to the side of the chair.

EMBLEMS:

- Each Star Point <u>with the exception of Martha</u> will step back and proceed to their pedestal in the same manner they did when getting their ribbons. Martha will stand at the side of her chair and extend her right arm with hand open, palm upward toward the broken column. She gives her lecture then drops her arm to her side.
- The other four Star Points pick up their emblem with their right hand, place the emblem on the palm of their left hand carrying it on a level with their elbows, then proceed to the side of the chair as they did with their ribbons.
- In returning the emblem to the pedestal, remain at the side of the chair until the Conductresses and new members have left their station and can no longer see the Star Point, then step in front of the chair, replace the emblem and be seated.

• Remember, the Star Points stand with nothing in their hands and are seated with nothing in their hands.


