STATED MEETING---The WM after consulting with the line officers decided that:

- HSB #174 will have Stated Meetings starting on September 10th at 6:30p.
- o A Packet of information will be emailed ahead of time as usual
- o The Air Exchange System will be shut off
 - The following COVID 19 Protocol will be followed;
 - Rods, tools, Sacred Book, door knobs etc. will be **sanitized** before and after the meeting
 - **Sanitizer** will be available
 - The **Registry book** will not be used, rather the S/T will call and record the roll

- **Temperatures** will be taken by "No Touch". If you have a temperature of 99 degrees or above you will not be allowed to enter.
- If you are **not feeling well** please do not attend.
- Masks will be required
